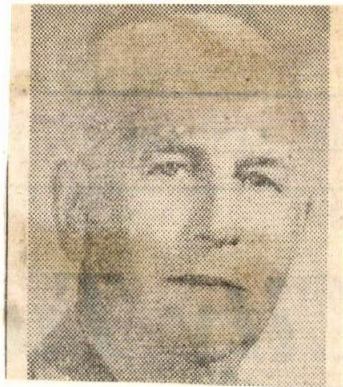

WINDHAM CENTER — Harry Frederick Adams, 82, of Pope Road, a Windham selectman 20 years, died Saturday at his home. He was first elected selectman in 1948 and did not seek re-election in 1968.

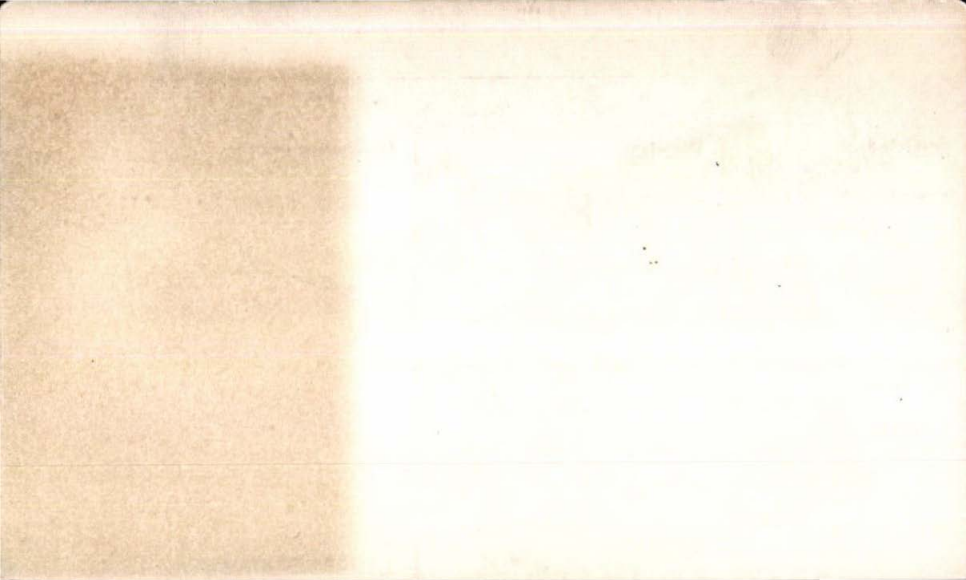

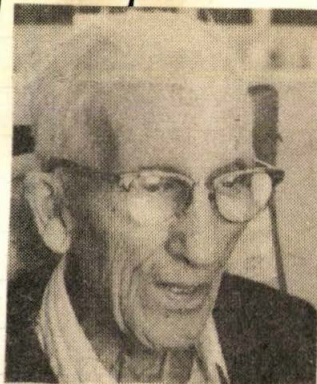
