BINGHAM — Milton G. Baker, 94, of Bingham, died Tuesday, March 13, 2001, at a Skowhegan hospital after a brief illness.

He was born Nov. 13, 1906, in Moscow, the second of three sons and a daughter born to Herman and Zelma (Albee) Baker, and graduated from Bingham High School in 1924.

He married Ethel Hunnewell on June 24, 1928.

Over his many years, he was employed in Bingham by V.I. Pierce Clothing, in Newfoundland doing timber cruising with Raymond Whitney, and at the Bingham railroad station.

During the depression, he joined the Civilian Conservation Corps (CCC). Later, he worked at Carry Pond. For many years, he was employed by Sanders Engineering Co. During the war, he worked at the South Portland shipyard and in the Coast Guard Reserves. He was a purchasing agent for Quimby Veneer Mill in Bingham. He retired from Raytheon in Waltham, Mass. He was very proud that he worked on the computer system that took the first man to the moon.

He was a 79-year member and past master of the Bingham Grange, member of Somerset Pomona, state and national Granges, past master of the Bingham Masonic Lodge and past president of Bingham Senior Citizens. He was very active in establishing the Bingham Health Center.

Milton enjoyed his many years of fishing and hunting. He loved his garden, raised house plants and, in his senior years, he began to oil paint scenes that he recalled in his mind.

His wife, Ethel Hunnewell Baker, two brothers, Kayle Baker and Stanley Baker, and a sister, Arlene Widgren, all died previously.

Survivors include a daughter, Annie Owens, and her husband, John, of Madison; a son, Lewis Baker, and his wife, Pauline, of Bingham; four grandchildren, James Owens, of Madison, Janet Wilson, and her husband, Scott, of Somersworth, N.H., Jordan Baker, and his wife, Kris, of Bingham, and Milton G. Baker II, and his wife, Jennifer, of Sparks, Nev.; eight great-grandchildren, Amy, Andrea and Micah Wilson, of Somersworth, N.H., Alicia and Justin Baker, of Bingham, Jillian, Alex and Luke Baker, of Sparks, Nev.; two sisters-in-law, Clara Baker, of Skowhegan, and Elsie Baker, of Beverly, Mass.; several nieces, nephews and cousins.

Friends and relatives may call from 7 to 9 p.m. Thursday, March 15, at Giberson Funeral Home, 18 River St., Bingham, with a 7:30 p.m. Masonic service.
