Belfast, April 18—Cecil F. Clay, 70, widely known court stenographer, died today at his home here following an illness with which he was stricken suddenly

while reporting the October term of the Waldo County Superior Court, over which Justice Arthur Chapman of Portland presided. He was taken to the Waldo County Hospital for treatment, but when it was discovered that his ailment was incurable he returned to his home.

Mr. Clay was born in Buxton, the son of Jonathan and Susie Brooks Clay, being a member of one of the prominent families in that town. His father died when he was 17 and soon after that he began his life work of stenographer. In addition to serving the Maine Supreme and Superior Courts and the State House of Representatives, he was also reporter for the Bering Sea Commission in 1894-95 and the St. John River Commission in 1909-13.

He was a member of the National Shorthand Writers' Association, Phoenix Lodge of Masons, Corinthian Royal Arch Chapter, King Solomon's Council and Palestine Commandery.

HENRY E. CLAY BURIED TODAY

PITTSFIELD, Oct. 28. (Special).—Friends attended the funeral services held today at his home on Main street for Henry E. Clay, a prominent citizen, who died Saturday morning at Grand Falls, N. B., as a result of injuries received in an automobile accident. Rev. F. L. McComb, pastor of the Universalist church, officiated, and interment was in the Pittsfield Village Cemetery.

Mr. and Mrs. Clay accompanied Mr. and Mrs. A. R. McNabb of Springfield, Mass., on a vacation trip through the province. The following Monday when the party was a short distance from Grand Falls late in the afternoon as they were rounding a sharp blind turn the car overturned. Mr. Clay was seriously injured, receiving a compound fracture of the leg. He was removed to a hospital at Grand Falls and he received the best care, but infection set in which proved fatal.

Mr. Clay is survived by his wife, Elsie Clay; one son, Vaughn; his daughter, Mrs. Ida Clay of Lincoln; two sisters, Mrs. Rose G. Keirstead of Greenville and Mary E. Keirstead of Greenville; six brothers, Virgil A. of Springfield, Leon B., Edward S., Alfred S., Charles W. of Lincoln and Ansel of Millinocket.

Mr. Clay was born in Springfield, Mass., Nov. 11, 1881. His parents moved to Lincoln when he was five years, and he attended the common schools here and Mattanawcook Academy. He was employed as timekeeper for Katahdin Pulp and Paper Company of Lincoln for several years, then going to Waltham, Mass., where he learned the jeweler's trade. He

He made many friends here by his cheerful disposition, and his early death brings sorrow to many. He was a member of the Masons of Lincoln, Ira Berry Chapter, R. A. M., of Pittsfield, the Council and the St. Omar Commandery of Waterville. He was affiliated with several jewelers' associations.

He was in the jewelry business in Lincoln and Millinocket and also worked at his trade in Camden, and for eight years with S. L. Rogers of Bangor before coming to Pittsfield in 1918, where he purchased the jewelry business of D. L. Allen, which he had since conducted successfully.

ISLESBORO (Dec 18): Robert Edmund Clayton, 92, of Pinehurst, N.C. and Islesboro, died Nov. 24, 2005, Thanksgiving Day, at home in Pinehurst from natural causes.

Mr. Clayton was born in Boston, Mass. He was raised in Hudson, Mass., Hannibal, Mo., and Rock Island, Ill. He earned a bachelor of science degree in chemical engineering from the State University of Iowa.

After two years in chemicals at Naugatuck Chemical Co. in Naugatuck, Conn., and five years in rubber reclaiming at Pequannoc Rubber Co. in Butler, N.J., he spent the remainder of his career at Exxon Mobil Corp., known at the time as Esso. He worked mainly at Exxon Research and Engineering Co. in Linden, N.J., focusing on rubbery polymers and plastics made from petroleum raw materials and earning the title of research associate.

His research and inventions contributed significantly to the war effort during World War II, when sources of natural rubber were not under Allied control. He was the originator of 27 U.S. patents and a member of the American Chemical Society.

He was proud of accomplishing much without an advanced degree. He put himself through college by playing saxophone and clarinet in dance bands. He played music most of his adult life, and the clarinet was under his bed when he died. He also enjoyed sailing, bridge, dancing and above all golf, making a hole-in-one at the age of 80 and playing regularly until nearly 90. He also introduced many friends and relatives to the pleasures of a summer home on Islesboro, which had been built by his own grandfather.

On Islesboro he was a Mason, belonging to Island Lodge No. 89 and playing sax in the Charlie Pendleton Band as often as he was on the island. He had a long and interesting life and will be greatly missed by those who loved him.

He was predeceased in 1979 by his wife of 39 years, Jean; and in 2005, by his wife of 25 years, Grace.

He is survived by his children, Ann Bjork (Lyle) of Seattle, Wash., Robert of Islesboro, and Philip (Isabelle) of Brussels, Belgium; Robert Smith (Barbara) of Novi, Mich., Richard Smith (Louise) of Nassau, N.H., Grace's son by a previous marriage; six grandchildren; one great-grandson; two children of Robert and Barbara Smith; two sisters, Doris Wenos (Harold) and Jean Carlson of Rock

Born at Bangor Oct. 3, 1875, son of Charles Davis and Catherine Dillingham Clarke, he came to this City, with his parents, at the age of two years. At the age of 15 he was forced to leave high school to earn his living, and entered the employ of the Burnham & Morrill Company, which he served in various positions, finally that of treasurer.

Upon entering politics, Mr. Clarke served as councilman and as alderman under the old form of government. He was elected mayor in 1917, and continued in that office for five terms, declining renomination in 1921.

In addition to his service as treasurer of the Episcopal Diocese, Mr. Clarke served on the Standing Committee and the Diocesan Council. He also was a member of the Greater and Lesser Chapters of the cathedral; was senior warden many years, and treasurer of the Maine Episcopal Missionary Society and of the Bishop Robert Codman Fund.

In May, 1932, he was appointed to fill a vacancy on the Board of County Commissioners, and in 1938 was made chairman, a position he held at the time of his death.

He served as receiver for several large corporations; and had been a director of the Canal National Bank since 1906. He was chairman of the Cumberland County Committee of Safety in World War I.

Mr. Clarke was a member of Ancient Landmark Lodge, AF&AM; the Sons of the American Revolution, Descendants of the Mayflower; the Cumberland Club and the Portland Club. He had also served as treasurer of the Children's Protective Society, and was a former treasurer of the Cumberland County Republican Committee.

Surviving are his widow, Mrs. Ellen Abbott Clarke; two daughters, Catherine Clarke Morrison, wife of Col. SANFORD, Aug. 5 (Special)—Charles D. Clark, 79, retired machinist of the Sanford Mill's, who made an addition to a loom at the Sanford Mills to produce the first perfect yard of material ever woven there, and who 56 years ago built Sanford's first horseless carriage, died Friday night at the Goodall Hospital.

Mr. Clark was born in Sanford, son of the late Daniel G., and Jane Chase Clark. The horseless carriage built by Mr. Clark was to be operated early in the morning on Main Street before the horses were out on the street.

Mr. Clark, son of the village blacksmith, was mechanically inclined, and when the Goodalls conceived the idea of weaving plush by power. Mr. Clark and the late James Goodall were set to work in a private room to make a machine. This was perfected and used to weave the narrow car plush.

Mr. Clark was one of the founders of the Sanford Unitarian Church and had been a Mason for 56 years, having been awarded the 50-year-medal by Preble Lodge of Sanford. He was a charter member of Sanford Lodge of Elks.

Mr. Clark is survived by his wife, Mrs. Katherine Pearce Clark, to whom he was married 56 years ago in December; one daughter, Mrs. Charles A. Trafton, Sanford, and one sister, Mrs. J. H. Neal of Portsmouth N. H.
