OWLS HEAD — Maurice Russell Harvey, 81, died March 13, 2001, at Knox Center for Long Term Care, Rockland. He was surrounded by his family.



Born at Ash Point, which was in South Thomaston, July 17, 1919, he was a son of Charles W. and Marion Dyer Harvey.

After his mother died when he was 2, he was raised by his father; his grandmother and grandfather, Effie and Linwood Dyer; and his aunt and uncle, Ellena and Alfred Fredette. He attended Ash Point schools and was a 1938 graduate of Rockland High School.

He married Helen Whitmore in Rockland July 27, 1940. They made their home at Ash Point, where they have lived since.

Mr. Harvey was in the U.S. Army during World War II, training at Camp Wheeler in Macon, Ga., and then serving in the European Theater.

For many years, he lobstered and seined for herring off Andrews Island, which his family owned. After retiring from fishing, he worked as a mail carrier in Owls Head, and for 13 years with his wife owned and operated O H Buoy, manufacturing reproduction buoys that were distributed throughout Maine.

Mr. Harvey served as an Owls Head selectman as well as in other town offices. He was a life member of the Rockland Lodge of Masons and a long-time active member of Owls Head Baptist Church, where he was a past deacon, trustee, usher and member of several other church boards.

Mr. Harvey is survived by his wife of Owls Head; two daughters, Lona H. Siebert and her husband, Harvey, of Owls Head, and Cheryl Lipman and her husband, Jerome, of Dover, N.H.; a son, Robert A. Harvey and his wife, JoEllen, of Owls Head; an aunt, Ellena Fredette of Spruce Head; six grandchildren, Traci Hartwick, Christopher Hall, Kimberly Peabody, Nathan Ames, Sarah R. Harvey and Jacob F. Harvey; and nine great-grandchildren.

SHELDON (TED) L. HARVEY

DOVER-FOXCROFT - Sheldon (Ted) L. Harvey, 81, passed quietly at home, Nov. 18, 2003. In his

final days he was comforted by family and friends. He was born Feb. 12, 1922, in Dover-Foxcroft, the son of Ralph M. and Mary Ellen Plummer Harvey.

After graduating from Foxcroft Academy in 1941, he enlisted in the U.S. Navy with his twin brother, Lawris "Bud" Harvey. During World War II, he and Bud served in North Africa and Okinawa. He married Elizabeth Hebel on Easter Sunday, April 1, 1945, prior to Ted's duty assignment in Okinawa. Ted worked 50 years in the building construction trade. In 1949, after working in the Bangor/Brewer area for T. W. Cunningham Construction Co., he returned to his home town, where he was employed by his brother, "Bus" as a foreman in the J.M. Harvey Construction Company. Following the death of his brother in 1966, Ted established his own carpentry and cabinet making business. He was well known as a skilled craftsman and respected as a man of integrity throughout the community. He served as a Boy Scout leader for 15 years and in 1963 received Scouting's most prestigious leadership award, the Silver Beaver. He was a member of Mosaic Masonic Lodge No. 52 AF & AM in Dover-Foxcroft and was Dad Advisor for DeMolav.

Ted was an active and devoted member of the Dover-Foxcroft Congregational United Church of Christ for more than 50 years. He served cheerfully in many capacities and was loved by all who knew him. Waldo E. 'Wally' Harwood Jr. 7/13/95 musician, band leader during Big Band era

Waldo E. "Wally" Harwood Jr., a former band leader and world traveler who loved the Boston Red Sox, died Wednesday. He was 91.

"He was a man of many, many talents, and he certainly had a zest for life," his wife, Sylvia Rowell Harwood, recalled Thursday.

His talents were varied, and he enjoyed three careers. His first career was as a musician.

In 1931, after graduating with distinction from the University of Maine, where he was a member of the Lambda Chi Alpha fraternity and a constant presence on the Dean's list, he led a group of musicians from the college on a tour of Italy.

Two years later, he returned to Italy with his own band, Wally Harwood and his Troubadours. The band played a month at the Club Casanova in Venice, another month at the Hotel Brunette in Bologna, two days at the Cafe Italia in Reggio and two weeks in the Grand Hotel at Riccione.

In Venice, Hoagy Carmichael, who wrote "Stardust," sat in with the band, and autographed Mr. Harwood's arrangement, writing, "Best band in Europe."

PASSAGES

Each day the newspaper selects one obituary and seeks to learn more about the life of a person who has lived and worked in Maine. We look for a person who has made a mark on the community or the person's family and circle of friends in small but lasting ways.

For more than 20 years during the Big Band era, Mr. Harwood played the saxophone, clarinet and flute. In 1938, tired of the road, he returned to Portland, and joined the staff orchestra of WCSH radio.

There, he met Sylvia Rowell, a staff violinist. They wed in 1939.

In 1940, he was appointed music director. He stayed in the job until 1949. He also played in the stage band of the Civic

Theater during the vaudeville era. He also played the Ricker Gardens, Riverside Ballroom and the Pier and Palace in Old Orchard Beach. "He loved when he used to play at the old pier," his son, Waldo Harwood III, said.

From 1944 to 1946, Mr. Harwood served in the U.S. Army as an infantry training cadre and leader of the regimental dance band.

Mr. Harwood began his second career after he left WCSH. For a number of years, he worked with his father in the wholesale lumber business.

In 1957, he began his third career when he joined Main Line Fence Co. He became vice president and general manager in 1961, and retired in 1981.

Retirement hardly slowed him down.

He and his wife traveled extensively, visiting Japan, Thailand, China, Hawaii, Egypt and all of Europe. They also enjoyed spring trips to most of the Caribbean island resorts with the Kora Temple.

He also learned to sew.

"It started because I was trying to learn how," his wife said. "He certainly helped me make the patterns. The next thing I knew, he was making the clothes. And our daughter's clothes, too. ... He did make most of my wardrobe." He made shirts for his son, as well.

Mr. Harwood was as comfortable in a wood shop as he was behind a sewing machine, and just recently finished building a new birdhouse.

As a young man, he was an excellent athlete, lettering in football, baseball, basketball and hockey at Deering High School, where he was a 1925 graduate. When his son was in school, Mr. Harwood was his Little League coach. And Mr. Harwood taught his children how to play music.

Even as an octogenarian, Mr. Harwood was active. He loved his summer home on Sebago Lake, and sailed into his 80s. He also enjoyed fishing and going to Jackman.

He was born in Attleboro, Mass., a son of W. Earle and Ruby Core Harwood.

He was a life member of the musicians union, Chandeliers Band, Cornerstone Lodge, Scottish Rites and the Kora Temple, where he played flute in the concert band and tenor saxophone in the 18-piece dance band. He also wrote arrangements for tunes of the 1930s and 1940s for "Nostalgia Nite" dances.

Surviving are his wife of 60 years of Portland, his son, Waldo Harwood III of Portland, a daughter, Nancy Harwood of Portland, two grandchildren, both of Portland, and a great-grandson of Portland.
