AUGUSTA – Leroy F. Hussey Sr., 96, died Sunday at the Maine Veteran's Home.

He was born here, son of Edgar A. and Lillian Parks Hussey, and attended the University of Maine two years until he enlisted in the Army and served with the 56th Pioneer Infantry in World War I.

At the end of the war, he entered Boston University, graduating in 1921.

In 1923, he married Ruth Vickery of Augusta. She died in 1969.

With his father and brother, Mr. Hussey founded Hussey Hardware Co. in 1921, serving as president until his retirement in 1981 and on the board of directors until 1993.

In 1971, he married Clara H. Arthur of Kingston, Ontario. She died in 1976.

Mr. Hussey was a member of Augusta's Board of Aldermen from 1925 to 1929, and was chairman from 1927 to 1929.

He was the first chairman of the Augusta Police Commission and a former member of the Augusta and Kennebec County Republican committees.

From 1931 to 1934, he was a member of the House of Representatives and of the Senate from 1935 to 1938.

Mr. Hussey was a member of the Governor's Executive Council from 1947 to 1952, serving as chairman in 1951-52.

He was a candidate for governor in 1952.

A past president of the Augusta Kiwanis Club and Red Cross, he also was a past exalted ruler of the Elks and a director of the Bank of Maine until 1985.

He was a past master of the Augusta Lodge of Masons, a past high priest of the Cushnoc Chapter, Royal Arch of Masons, a past potentate of Kora Temple Shrine and a past director of Put Stevens Court, Royal Order of Jesters.

Mr. Hussey served on the state YMCA camp committee, and was a member of Kennebec Valley Chamber of Commerce, Maine State Grange, the Order of the Eastern Star, the Fitzgerald-Cummings Post, American Legion, and the Scottish and York Rite bodies. He was a







Immigrant picked as top teacher

SALT LAKE CITY (AP) — Six years after leaving Vietnam, Luc Pham has been named Teacher of the Year for the Salt Lake City School District, where he has taught English to hundreds of students at Washington Elementary School.

Most of his 1st- through 6thgrade students are Asian, but with a minority enrollment of 40 percent the school draws students from many backgrounds. Luckily, Pham, 38, is fluent in five languages — Vietnamese, French, English, Chinese and Spanish.

Pham worked as a teacher, then as a translator and intelligence officer in the U.S. Embassy during the Vietnam War. He was cap-

trained as a forester at the University of Maine so he could manage his family's Dead River Co., which owned thousands of forest acres in Maine.

He also became president of the Bangor & Aroostook Railroad, director of the Association of American Railroads, president of the New England Council and a direc-

tor of several major corporations. Mr. Hutchins joined Dead River as treasurer in the early '30s and became its president and board chairman in 1935. He diversified the company by going into oil distribution and recreational land developments. Dead River became one of the larger oil distribution firms in Maine.

He became a Navy officer in World War II and was borrowed by the War Production Board to head up its paper division. In that role he handled paper allocations and directed a program in which the government tried, unsuccessfully, to turn German prisoners of war

into pulpwood cutters. In 1944 he became a director of the Bangor & Aroostook, served as president from 1948-57 and two years thereafter as board chairman.

As president, he dieselized the "potato road" locomotives within three years, speeded up service, cut freight rates and modernized rolling stock. Mr. Hutchins was instrumental

in creating Bangor Punta Corp., a nationwide conglomerate that later acquired Piper Aircraft and was in turn taken over by Lear Siegler. He was a Bangor Punta director

and served on numerous other boards.

An active Republican, he represented Bangor in the Maine House in 1943 and was on the Bangor City Council for several years

In 1975, Mr. Hutchins was ap-pointed a member of the Roosevelt-Campobello International Park Commission.

Mr. Hutchins and his wife do-nated \$1 million to the University of Maine's School of Forest Re-sources in 1981. The gift was dedcated to starting programs and courses and to the creation of proessorships.

He never outgrew his fascinaion for the Maine woods and was in avid salmon fisherman. Last riday he attended a supper of the Mirimichi Salmon Club at Boesown, New Brunswick, where he vas publicly recognized for his ifelong contributions to the sport. le spent part of Saturday picnickng with former baseball great Ted Villiams, a friend of many years. He received honorary degrees

from Colby College in Waterville in 1949, the University of Maine in 1951, Husson College in 1971 and from Thomas College in 1985.

He was a director of American Woolen Co., Atlas Plywood Corp., Avis Inc., Bangor Punta Corp., Guilford Industries Inc., Merrill Trust Co., Scott Paper Co., State Street Bank and Trust Co. of

Boston and Northeast Airlines Inc. At the time of his death, he was commissioner of Roosevelt Campobello International Park, a trustee of the College of the Atlantic in Bar Harbor and a member of Phi Beta Kappa. He was also a member of the University of Maine Pulp and Paper Foundation and a trustee of Bangor Theological Seminary.

He was a past member of the Maine Environmental Im-provement Commission and the Bangor City Council, serving as its chairman in 1943.

He was a member of the Ameri-

can Pulpwood Association and was its president in 1946 and 1947. He was a member of the Colby College Investment Committee, the Maine Higher Education Committee, the Canadian-American Committee of the National Plan-ning Association, the United Na-tions Mission to Chile in 1959, the Governors Committee of Forest Legislation, the State Credit Research Committee, the Governor's Seed Committee (chairman) and a member and trustee of Eastern Maine General Hospital.

Mr. Hutchins was a past director of Maine Development Corp. and the Association of American Railroads.

He was a member of the Brook Club of New York City, the Pinna-cle Club of New York City, the Union Club of Boston, the Penob-scot Valley Country Club, the Downtown Club of Boston, Tarran-tine Club and the Pot and Kettle Club of Bar Harbor Club of Bar Harbor.

Surviving are a son, Christopher Bangor, and two daughters, of Bangor, and two daughters, Hope Blackburn of New York and Hilda McCollom of Chevy Chase, Md. His wife of 53 years, Ruth Rich Hutchins, died in December 1984.

WELLS – Elmer C. Hutchins, 79, of High Pine, retired chief of police for the towns of Wells and North Berwick, died Thursday at a local hospital.

Chief Hutchins was town constable in Wells during the 1930s and later served many years as the town's only officer. As the force grew over the years, Hutchins used to joke that it took about 20 officers to do the job he did by himself, said his son, Norman Hutchins of Wells. 19

Elmer Hutchins served 24 years as a Wells officer, serving as chief for part of that time. In the late 1960s, he

Chief Hutchins was shot in August 1975 while investigating a domestic dispute. As he approached a house where there had been a complaint of a knifing, he was shot by an 18-yearold with a rifle.

Chief Hutchins retired shortly after that incident, later working as a security guard for Coastal Security Co., Kennebunk, and then for Ness Security Co., guardiant Flant in Sanford.

Born in Wells, he was a son of Edward F. and Izetta Hilton Hutchins, and attended Wells schools.

He served in the National Guard during World War II.

Chief Hutchins was twice a selectman in Wells, for eight years during the 1940s and four years during the 1970s. He had to step down while he was police chief.

He was a former Wells road commissioner, a longtime member of the Wells Corner Hose Company and a York County deputy sheriff for several years.
