





Auburn, Oct. 22—G. Eldon Jones, for 60 years a resident of Auburn, and well known in musical circles for a half century, died Wednesday afternoon at the State Odd Fellows

home in Auburn.

Mr. Jones was born in Winthrop, Oct. 9, 1861, the son of George and Charlotte (Heald) Jones. He came to Auburn in 1878. For many years he was bookkeeper and shipping clerk for the Oscar Holway Co., dealers in flour and grain. After the firm went out of business, Mr. Jones sold insurance.

He possessed an excellent tenor voice, and became a member of the well-known High St. Methodist church quartet in 1885. board.

Mr. Jones married Miss Bertha A. Pulsifer in 1837. She died in 1890 and he married Harriet E. Smith in 1893. Her death occured in 1915. Mr. Janes went to the Odd Fellows Home to reside four years ago. He is survived by a sister, Mrs. Ida E. Ham, and a sister-in-law, Mrs. Oscar W. Jones, both of Auburn.

He was a member of Abou Ben Adhem lodge, L. O. O. F., and Ma-

sonic orders.
