## Rev. George Kent, Maine Cleric, Dies

FALL RIVER, Mass., Feb. 14 Special)—The funeral of the Rev. George Henry Kent, 78, prominent retired Maine clergyman who preached the funeral sermon for Hannibal Hamlin, Vice President of the United States under President Abraham Lincoln, was held at the Potter Funeral Chapel at Westport this afternoon.
