## Donald C. Kimball

Funeral services will be held at 2 p. m. Saturday from 11 Mellen Street for Donald C. Kimball, 55, a lifelong resident of this city and a member of the old City Council, who died Wednesday in his home, 32 St. Lawrence Street, after an illness of four months. Interment will be in Forest City Cemetery.

He was born here Nov. 27, 1893, son of the late Gardiner L. and Margaret Easler Kimball. An electrician by trade, Mr. Kimball served his apprenticeship with the James H. Cary Electrical Works and later, with his brothers, bought the business. He served as treasurer and general manager of the firm for many years before selling his interests about 20 years ago.

He had been employed as a civilian inspector in the Navy Department since early in World War II, serving as ordnance inspector at the Bath Iron Works, Navy Yard in Washington, D. C., and in a gun factory in Washington. He had been working for the department in New York City at the time of his illness four months ago.

Mr. Kimball served two years on the City Council from Ward 1 just before the adoption of the manager-council form of government here. He was a member of the St. Lawrence Congregational Church and formerly was active in the Thirteen Class there, Portland Masonic Lodge, AF&AM, Odd Fellows and the Order of the Golden Cross.

Besides his widow, the former Elsie I. Clough of Portland, he is survived by two sons, Donald G. Kimball, Kittery, and Burt M. Kimball, Portland; a daughter, Mrs. Eugene S. Marsh, Portland; a sister, Mrs. Idabelle Shields, South Portland, and eight grandchildren.
