Harry P. Lowell, 72, for more than 40 years employed by the former A. H. Berry Shoe Company of this city, much of the time as head shipper, died Tuesday night in the Maine General Hospital after several months of failing health. A resident of Greater Portland all his life, he had lived on Long Island in recent years.

Mr. Lowell was born here April 10, 1875, son of the late Bartlett and Celia Wallace Lowell, and attended public schools. As a young man he entered the employ of the local shoe manufacturing firm, continuing until it closed its business, when he retired. During the recent war he was employed by the Southworth Machine Company, giving up work in 1943 on account of illness.

He was a member of Deering Lodge, No. 183, AF&AM, and Greenleaf Chapter, RAC, in this city, also of Congress Street Methodist Church in earlier years and later of the North Deering Congregational Church.

Last August, Mr. and Mrs. Lowell observed the 50th anniversary of their marriage at their home on Long Island.

Mr. Lowell is survived by his widow, Mrs. Mary Foster Lowell, Long Island; a daughter, Mrs. Ella Barnard, Mechanic Falls; two sons, Leon W. Lowell, South Portland, and Alfred Lowell, Long Island; a sister, Mrs. Esther S. Goss, Gardiner; a brother, Lindon W. Lowell, Portland; and three grandchildren, Robert Barnard, Mechanic Falls, and LeRoy Lowell and Anita Lowell, Long Island.

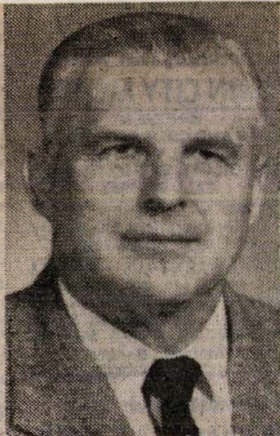
