Funeral services for Wesley J. Maynard, 86, retired railroad man, formerly employed at the Maine Central shops at Waterville and the Portland Terminal shops at Thompson's Point in this city, were held at 2 p. m. Thursday in the home of his daughter, Mrs. Leon C. Staples, 27 Urban Street, Stamford, Conn. Mr. Maynard, who moved to Stamford in 1925, died there. Interment will be in Pine Grove Cemetery, Waterville.

Mr. Maynard was born Nov. 10, 1853, at Winslow, son of Joseph and Mary Maynard and was educated in the public schools of Waterville and Coburn Classical Institute. As a young man he learned the carpenter's trade and at the age of 19 years went to work for the Maine Central Railroad in the Waterville shops.

Later Mr. Maynard became foreman of the Thompson's Point shops, and a few years before his retirement at the age of 65 he was in charge of the wrecking crew working at the Portland Terminal Station. His wife, Mrs. Cora Maynard, died here in 1925.

He was a lifelong member of the Methodist Church, a 32nd degree Mason, and an Odd Fellow.

Besides his daughter, who is wife of the superintendent of the Stamford public schools, he leaves two grandchildren, Cornelia and Miriam Staples.

## EDWARD G. MEADER

WATERVILLE, Nov. 8. (Special).—Edward G. Meader, Waterville's oldest citizen, died this morning at the age of 99, after an illness of nearly three years.

Mr. Meader was born in Farmington, N. H., Oct. 27, 1825. He came to Waterville in December, 1848. He worked as a clerk in a general store for two years and then in company with G. A. Phillips and William Blake conducted a dry goods business, building the brick block which is now known as the Wardwell Dry Goods Company block. He remained in this business until 1868, and then entered into a partnership with his father-in-law, Gen. Franklin Smith, in the manufacture and sale of lumber.
