# R. Francis Parker Dies At Skowhegan

Special Despatch to The Press Herald

Skowhegan, Sept. 9—R. Francis Parker, 90, one of Skowhegan's oldest citizens, died this afternoon in the house in which he was born, the son of Simon and Saphronia Whitcomb Parker, the last of a family of four.

In 1870, at the age of 20, he married Helen Robinson. She died in 1923.

Mr. Parker leaves two sons, Eugene E., a farmer on the East River road, and Dr. E. A. Parker, Osteopathic physician at Skowhegan.

From 1889 to 1915 he was a member of the Skowhegan Board of Selectmen, in 1902 he became chairman of the board, holding this office until his retirement in 1915. He was a past master of Skowhegan Grange and a Mason more than 50 years and was a Democrat. During the time he was a selectman he became associated in grocery and meat business with the late George Nay in the store now occupied by Smith and Casey, and at that time he maintained his residence on East Leavitt Street.

At his retirement in 1916, he returned to his farm home, where until a few weeks ago he was active in the management. Funeral services will be held at 2 p. m. Wednesday at the home, the Rev. Thomas S. Cleaver of the Federated Church officiating.

AUBURN — Walter E. (Luke) Parker, 81, of 285 Park Ave., Auburn, died Friday night at Central Maine Medical Center in Lewiston.

Born in Auburn, Oct. 27, 1902, he was the son of Walter G. and Gertrude Emery Parker. Mr. Parker received his education in the schools of Dover-Foxcroft and Auburn and graduated from Edward Little High School in 1921. He was married in 1935 to the former Ethel G. Foss. She died in 1952. On Oct. 12, 1958 in Auburn, he married the former Bernice Caton Bickford. Mr. Parker was employed by the Union Water Power Co. in Lewiston for 23 years and was a construction engineer, retiring in 1967. He was a past master of the Ancient Brothers Lodge of Masons AF & AM 178 of Auburn and was also a member of the Maine Association of Engineers.

Karl M. Pattee, 88, of Cambridge, a retired colonel in the Army Corps of Engineers, who served in both world wars, died Saturday in Mt. Auburn Hospital in Cambridge after suffering a ruptured aneurism. Col. Pattee had been ill with a lingering coronary heart disease. *5-18-85*

After World War II he was executive officer for the Corps of Engineers in Boston until 1948, when he took on civilian status in Brooklyn, N.Y., and worked for an architect in Portland, Maine, and for an architect-engineering firm in Boston from 1925 to 1928.

His wife, the former Marjorie Haworth of Cambridge, said during a telephone conversation yes-

terday that he was self-employed from 1928 until 1933 during the Depression. "It was a hard time and we had to use up our savings ..." Then in 1933, she continued, he was called to active duty as a reserve officer and went on duty with the old Civilian Conservation Corps in charge of construction and maintenance of CCC camps in New England." He had been with the Army Corps of Engineers during World War I.

Col. Pattee was a member and a deacon of the First Church Congregational in Cambridge, a member for life of the Limington (Maine) Masonic Lodge and a 32d degree Mason; and a past president of the Boston Philatelic Society.
