Captain Quick, who died here Monday, was born in Newfoundland and began a seafaring career, which lasted 57 years, at the age of nine. He retired in 1939 after having been with the Texas Company for 23 years. Previously he commanded schooners and full-rigged ships for A. Sewall & Company of Bath for 23 years. He was a former trustee of the Maine Nautical School and a former member of the Board of Governors of the Propeller Club of Portland.

For the Texas Company, Captain Quick sailed to U. S. Atlantic coast ports, the Dutch East Indies, and ports in Europe and around the Mediterranean. In 1931, he brought the tanker Texas to Portland to open the Texas Company's new facilities at Pleasantdale.

Captain Quick sailed under the British flag for eight years. In 1890 he shipped before the mast on the schooner Talofa, owned by A. Sewall & Company of Bath, became mate of the schooner within three years, and in 1893 was given command of the three-masted schooner Carrie A. Lane of the Sewall fleet. He then commanded Sewall's wooden ship Henry Villard for three years before taking command of the steel ship Edward Sewall. He was master of the Edward Sewall for 20 years, for 16 years while the ship was under the Sewall house flag and four for the Texas Company, which bought the big square-rigger in 1916. Later for the Texas Company he commanded the motorship Maryland, tug Pan American, and the deep-water tankers Louisiana, Texas,

Dungannon, California, and Connecticut.

Makes Horn Voyage

In the Edward Sewall, one of the largest sailing ships under American registry, he made the classic long voyage around Cape Horn, 293 days from Philadelphia to Seattle. For bringing the ship through an ordeal of misadventure, storm, and contrary winds he won renown for his courage and determination and a place in sailing ship history as one of the world's most dogged and persevering sailors.

Captain Quick served on the Sagadahoc County Selective Service Board during World War II. He had been president of the Kennebec Marine Museum of Bath since 1942, when he succeeded the late Comdr. John A. Lord, USNR, rebuilder of Old Consides, and a corporator of the Bath Savings Institution since 1944.

He was a member of Polar Star of Masons, Dunlap Commandery, Knights Templar, and Emery & St. Bernard Royal Chapter.

Surviving are his widow, the Mrs. Jessie Bell; two daughters, Mrs. Belle Connard and Mrs. Helen Connard; and four grandchildren of Bath.

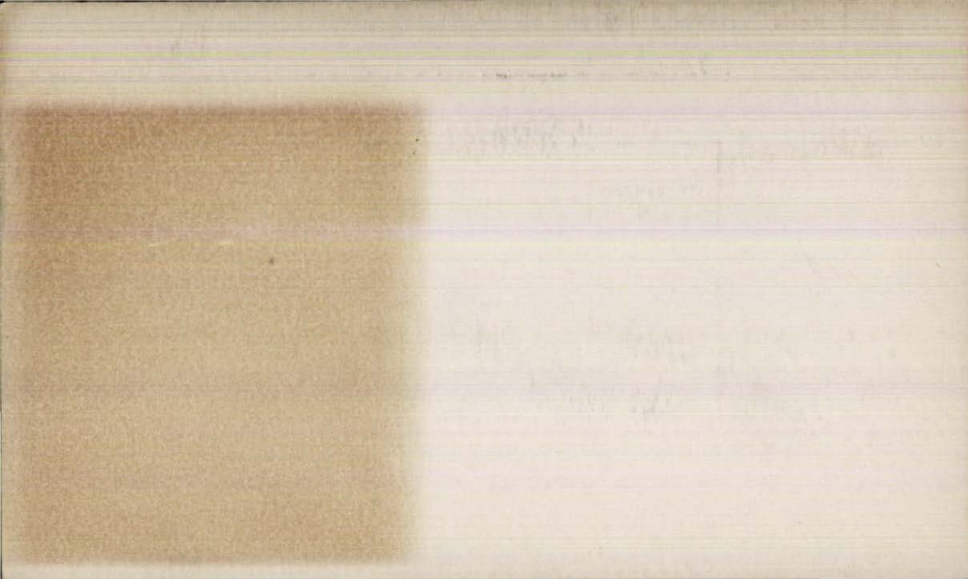

Funeral services for Allen Quimby, 63, timberland owner and lumber manufacturer, who died Thursday morning in his home, 129 Pitt Street, will be held at 2 p. m. Saturday from

his residence. Thrombosis, following a week's illness with the grip, caused his death. Mr. Quimby, a Northern Maine operator, was known as the dean of the plywood industry.

Mr. Quimby was born April 12, 1873, at North Sandwich, N. H., and was graduated from Phillips Exeter Academy in 1892 and Bowdoin College in 1895. At Bowdoin he was prominent in athletics and achieved distinction in the study of anthropology, being appointed by Dr. Franz Boas, Chief of the Bureau of Ethnology in Washington, assistant in connection with the bureau's exhibition at the Columbia Exposition in Chicago.

He was a member of the faculty of Cony High School at Augusta from 1896 to 1901. Admitted to the Maine Bar in 1900, he continued teaching until 1901, when he engaged in the manufacture of birch veneer at Greenville. A year later he removed to Stockholm and five years later to Houlton, where his interests had remained since.

In 1927 he became associated with the Northern Plywood Company as treasurer. He owned an orange grove at Clearwater, Fla., as well as extensive real estate holdings. From 1923 to 1928 he engaged in the manufacture of canning machinery with the late Frank W. Smith of Portland.

Mr. Quimby was a Republican, a member of Caribou Lodge, F. & A. M., of the State Street Congregational Church in Portland and of the Portland Economic Club.

His first wife, Mrs. Millie Smith Quimby, died in 1919. Surviving are his widow, Mrs. Marcia Smith Quimby; four children, Allen Quimby, Jr., of Houlton, Mrs. Janette L. Daly of Clearwater, Fla., and Langdon C. Quimby of Houlton, children of the first marriage; and Kenneth Quimby of Portland, a child of the second marriage; one grandchild, Julianne Quimby of Houlton; two sisters, Mrs. Ida Q. Moulton of Auburndale, Mass., and Mrs. Sarah Burleigh of Augusta; and two brothers, the Rev. Joseph Langdon Quimby of Augusta and Dr. John Grant Quimby of Meredith, N. H.

Charles Quimby, lifelong mission was to help others

ISLESBORO — Charles H. "Bobbin" Quimby, 94, a man known for his kind-hearted, giving nature, died April 4, 2000, at MaineGeneral Medical Center, Augusta.

He was born here, a son of Charles E. and Harriett Hartstone Quimby. He attended Islesboro schools until

his father's death, when he left to care for his two younger brothers. Residents of the island helped the brothers, and Mr. Quimby vowed he would repay them for their kindness, his family said.

Mr. Quimby kept his word. As an adult he often took it upon himself to feed or clothe those who needed help — sometimes even giving them the food from his own table. Although he was never wealthy, his daughter-in-law Patricia Quimby said, "if he had a five-dollar bill it was for somebody else."
