MAURICE REGINALD "MO" THIBAUT

SOUTH PARIS -- Maurice "Mo" Reginald Thibault, 81, of Rangeley, died early Thursday morning, Dec. 13, 2007, at the Maine Veterans' Home in South Paris where he had resided for the last two years.

He was born Nov. 16, 1926, in Auburn, the son of Joseph and Mainie (Guilbeault) Thibault. He graduated from Portland High School. He then enlisted in the Navy where he served for two years.

After his discharge from the Navy, he attended New England Institute of Anatomy and Embalming in Boston. Upon his graduation he served his funeral service apprenticeship at Knowlton and Hewins Funeral Homes in Augusta and Hallowell and later owned and operated Thibault Funeral Home in Rangeley for more than 40 years with his wife, Marilyn "Mickey" Thibault. He also operated the Rangeley Ambulance Service for many years and worked at DC Morton and Sons in Rangeley for 26 years.

He was a member of Kemankeag Masonic Lodge No. 213 of Rangeley, York Rites, and the Valley of Portland. He was past president of the Western Mountain Shrine Club, the Rangeley Snowmobile Club, and the Rangeley Republican Town Committee. He was a member of the Rangeley American Legion, served as a Meals On Wheels driver, and was an active communicant of the Church of the Good Shepherd in Rangeley.

He is survived by his wife, Marilyn "Mickey" of Rangeley; two sons, David and his wife, Patricia, of Lake Mary, Fla., and Dennis and his wife, Anne, of Mechanic Falls; a daughter, Denise Mercier and her husband, William, of Rangeley; 10 grandchildren and three great-grandchildren.

Funeral services will be held at 11 a.m. Saturday from the Church of the Good Shepherd, Main Street, Rangeley, followed by Masonic services performed by Kemankeag Masonic Lodge No. 213. of 69 15th St., Bangor, died quietly at his home on Sunday, Dec. 3, 1989. He was predeceased by his wife, Elsie Thibodeau, in 1984. Mr. Thibodeau was born in Carroll, July 24, 1894, the son of Gordon and Ida (Thornton) Thibodeau. He spent his boyhood on the family farm in Carroll. In the spring of 1917, he joined the Maine National Guard as a member of the Second Maine Infantry. His division entered federal service in the summer of 1917. "Bumpa" served in four major engagements with his division before being wounded. His regiment was one of two from the 26th Yankee Division that led off the last great offensive of World War I. At the time of his death, he was the last honorary commander of his regiment. After his return from military service, he returned to his home in Carroll. At this time, he was a teamster and in one winter alone, with one other logger, forrested 99 trees and hauled them down a mountainside to the boom at lakeside. Following that winter, he entered Shaw Business College in Portland. In 1928, he became an employee at the Bangor Post Office and remained there until his retirement in

1966. Masonically, he was a member of Forest Lodge No. 148 of Springfield for 68 years, being made a life member in 1975; a member of Mt. Moriah Royal Arch Chapter No. 6 of Bangor; Bangor Council Royal Select Masters; Saint John's Commandry No. 3, Bangor; past commander Tamerlane No. 4 Knights of the Red Cross of Constantine and past sovereign; the Scottish Rite Bodies Valley of Bangor; Maine Consistory 32nd Degree, Portland; and Anah Temple Shrine of Bangor. In 1989, he was the recipient of the Knights Templar Cross of Honor. From a very musically talented family, he was an accomplished musician on the violin and the banjo. At the age of 12, he had the opportunity to study violin at the New England Conservatory of Music. Along with his brother, Vaughn, now of Ellsworth, he played during the 20's and 30's in many small dance bands around eastern Maine. "Bumpa" has passed this heritage to his one daughter, Mrs. Frank (Joan) Gardiner; and two granddaughters, Mrs. Galen (Gail) Joeckel and Mrs. Gary (Deborah) Leighton, all of Bangor; and a grandson, Joel P. and his wife, Judith Gardiner of Boston,

Mass., all of whom play musical instruments; great-grandchildren, Jessica and Jennifer Sabin, and Alison Leighton, all of Bangor, who also share his musical abilities; nieces and nephews. Friends may call 3-5 and 7-9 p.m. Tuesday at Brookings-Smith, 133 Center St., Bangor, where relatives and friends are invited to a Masonic memorial service at 7:30 p.m., conducted by the officers of St. Andrew's Lodge. Funeral services will be held 12 noon Wednesday at Brookings-Smith, with the Rev. Sidney Buzzell, a friend and neighbor, and minister of the Grace United Methodist Church, officiating. 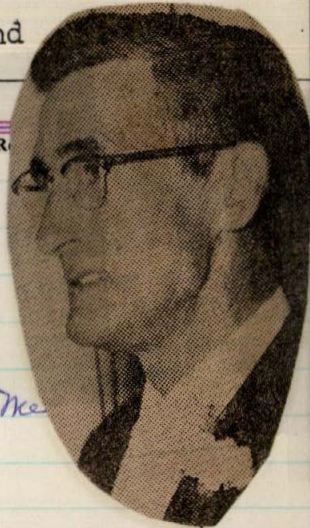
