BERWICK, Maine - Willis S. "Ty" Wentworth, 82, of 66 Wentworth Road died Sunday, July 9, 1995, at Wentworth-Douglass Hospital in Dover, N.H.

Arthur S. Wescott, applied innovative ideas to farming

STANDISH — Arthur S. Wescott, 92, a farmer who became well-known for his innovative methods of making money off the land, died April 14, 2000, in a Portland hospital.

Mr. Wescott garnered several headlines in local newspapers in the 1950s and 1960s for, among other things, growing white tomatoes, using geese to weed his fields, and selling the rocks that cluttered his soil.

PASSAGES

Each day the newspaper selects one obituary and seeks to learn

more about the life of a person who has lived and worked in Maine.

We look for a person who has made a mark on the community or the person's family and circle of friends in lasting ways.

For 11 decades, Mr. Wescott's farmstand on Route 35 near Sebago Lake was the primary source of vegetables for tourists and locals alike.

"He just loved to see stuff grow," said a son, Dana Wescott of Gorham. "And he was very good at making sure that things did grow."

Mr. Wescott was born in Standish, a son of Arthur C. and Ina L. Shaw Wescott, and attended local schools. As a young boy, he worked at ice houses on Otter Pond, working nine-hour days for \$3. Following his education, he and his family moved to the Portland area and he worked first as a bellhop at the Eastland Hotel and then at the Portland Stove Foundry.

"He came up the hard route," his son said. "He was pretty gruff and tough. He would tell it like it is and not pull any punches."

He learned carpentry and worked on ammunition boats on Peaks Island. He returned to work for Sebago Ice Co. of Portland and delivered ice to the Woodfords area.

Mr. Wescott then worked at the South Portland Shipyard, and during that time, married the former Mary Bustin. He returned to Standish and he and his wife raised chickens and sold them to his friends at the shipyard.

He moved to Route 35 in 1940 and started his 26-year career as a farmer. He shipped raspberries and strawberries to Boston markets. His geese and ducks, totaling as many as 175 at times, were particularly good at eating the weeds out of the raspberry fields.

He started selling rocks after he found quartz in his fields. His farmstand customers would quickly buy them up at 25 cents apiece for rock gardens.

Following retirement, he still raised blueberries and had 20 acres of Christmas trees and his own flock of ducks.

He had been a guide on Sebago Lake. He was a 50-year member of the Standish Masonic Lodge and the Kora Temple Shrine.

His first wife died in 1978. His second wife, Marg Bailey Wescott, died in 1990.

Surviving are two sons, Dana L. of Gorham and Thomas B. of Naples; a sister, Martha Leavitt of Buxton; six grandchildren and 11 great-grandchildren.

Visiting hours will be from 7 to 9 p.m. Monday at Dolby and Dorr Funeral Chapel, 76 State St., Gorham, where a funeral service will be held at 10 a.m. Tuesday with the Rev. Philip Shearman officiating. Burial will follow in Dow's Corner Cemetery.

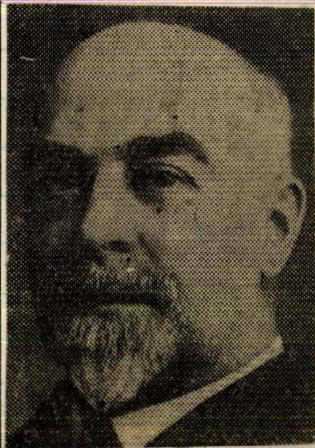

ville, Mass., Aug. 20, 1862, the son of General Warren West, Civil War officer, and Sarah Ann Frost West, and was a descendant of Wilkes West, who settled in Beverly, Mass., in 1735. He received his preparatory schooling in his native city, graduating from the Latin High School there. He then entered Harvard College, but left shortly after entering in order to enter business.

It was in 1882 that Mr. West came to Portland and became associated with his uncle, the late George P. Westcott of this city, long prominent in business and political affairs in Portland and the state. In this connection Mr. West became identified early in his business career in the building and operating of water works, gas and electric properties in New England and the West.

He was president of the Biddeford & Saco Water Company, the York County Water Company, utilities which had been built up under the business genius of Mr. Westcott. He was a director of the Portland National Bank, and the Biddeford National Bank for many years, also of the former Union Safe Deposit and Trust Company, which a few years ago was consolidated with the Portland National. He had also served as a member of the board of directors of the Union Mutual Life Insurance Company over a long period.

A Republican in politics, Mr. West took great interest in civic affairs, and was one of the supporters of the movement resulting in the adoption of the non-partisan Council-Manager form of municipal government in Portland, being elected a member of the first board upon its adoption by popular vote in 1923.

Many other interests also claimed his attention and devotion. He was president of the Maine State Board of Trade and its successor, the State Chamber of Commerce, for several terms, and also took a prominent part in sessions of the United States Chamber of Commerce, serving on committees of the latter. He was president of the Portland Young Men's Christian Association from 1920 to 1936, as well as a member of its board for a longer period. He was made a member of the International Committee of the YMCA, in January, 1932, an appointment which came in recognition of his general as well as local service to the organizations.

Mr. West was a member of the State Street Congregational Church and in his more active years was prominent in its councils.

Mr. West's recreational interests in former years included yachting, and he was a member of the Portland Yacht Club and the Corinthian Yacht Club of Marblehead, Mass. He also held membership for some years in the Portland Country Club. In fraternal circles he was affiliated with the Masons.

On April 12, 1886, he married Miss Jennie Estelle Means of Millbridge, Mass., who survives him with a son, Vernon Frost West, who is associated with the water and utility interests, his father for many years directed under the firm name of George F. West & Son, 98 Exchange Street.
